### PROFILE OF OUR YOUTH & FAMILIES

Our surveys examine practices and attitudes related to substance use and other risky behaviors, as well as perceptions of mental health and school, family, and community supports.

## Trumbull is on the right track...



#### Our efforts to build a strong foundation for our youth are working.

- Youth use of alcohol, marijuana, prescription drugs and vapes has decreased dramatically since 2010.
- The majority of our teens know where to get help if they have a concern or problem.
- Most students feel their teachers and classmates care about them.



#### **Family Norms in Trumbull Support Prevention**

- Trumbull parents are setting rules and expectations around alcohol & drug use, and modeling responsible behaviors.
- Trumbull parents are taking steps to prevent alcohol, binge drinking, vaping and marijuana use.

## But there are still challenges ahead...



4 out of 10 Trumbull High School students report they felt sad or hopeless for 2 weeks or more and stopped doing some usual activities in the past year.



Low perception of harm and behaviors around youth marijuana use are concerning. 14% of Trumbull High School seniors reported driving a car under the influence of marijuana.



Access to alcohol continues to be reported as 'easy' by Trumbull teens. The majority of high school youth report getting alcohol from their home or a friend's home.
