1. Introductions & Partner Updates:

- a. Tim Hare invites all to attend the Blessing of the Animals at Trumbull Congregational Church on Sunday (10/20) at 3pm. The event will include pet adoption and Sunday School-made dog toys will be available for purchase.
- b. Next week is Red Ribbon Week at the middle schools. TPAUD provided support through:
 - i. Development of scenario-based, grade-level specific refusal skills activity for use during Advisory,
 - ii. Purchasing RRW photo backdrops for each school,
 - iii. Providing positive social norming facts from TPAUD student survey for morning announcements,
 - iv. Providing YAY video to introduce RRW.
- c. TPAUD will offer drop-in Narcan training, free Narcan and lockboxes at Drug Take Back Day (10/26 from 10-2 at TEMS).
- d. CatalystCT The Hub released a Request for Proposals for cannabis prevention (\$28.5k per year for 2 years). Two grant have will be funded for Region 1 (Greenwich to Stratford). TPAUD intends to apply, possibly in collaboration with neighboring towns.

2. Gillian Anderson – My Friend Abby Update

- a. My Friend Abby received a Trumbull ARPA Non-Profit Grant of \$12,500 for mental health projects in Town through 6/30/25. Planned Town ARPA Non-Profit Grant activities include speakers, Peer Project grants, and Community Projects for young adults.
- b. THS MFA Club: will kick off at THS on Friday, 10/25 with an afterschool speaker event (Johnny Crowder). The club will include students previously involved in YAY and S.A.V.E. Promise, plus interested new members. Club advisor is Darsi Baer.
- c. TPAUD and MFA intend to co-sponsor an event featuring SHU's Executive Director of Wellness Services James Geisler, to promote his Thrive Year 1: The Essential Mental Health Workbook for First-Year College Students.

3. Community/Family Education:

- a. THS 9th Grade Forum: Planning is underway for the THS 9th Grade Forum (11/19). Coalition members are encouraged to volunteer.
- b. Coalition members discussed priorities for programming, including:
