 - i. QPR & Narcan Trainings:
 - 1. TPAUD, in collaboration with the Health Department, will be conducting the following Narcan trainings.
 - a. Senior Center staff and volunteers on April 22nd
 - b. Madison PTA's Family Health Fair on April 24th
 - c. Parks & Rec summer staff on May 20th
 - d. Trumbull Farmers' Market on June 6th, August 1st and October 3rd

 - Legislative Update:
 - 1. HB 5150: Legislators continue to work on this bill to regulate cannabis products, including a provision to regulate beverages containing cannabis, including hemp-based THC. This bill would also prohibit coupons and discounts. You can read the latest version here.
 - 2. HB 5284: Places advertising restrictions on gambling. More information can be found here.
 - 3. HB 5201: Require funding of tobacco control programs to prevent and reduce tobacco use at the amount recommended by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention. More info here.
